

NAPPS DONALD C. 'MAC' MACDONALD AWARD

In August 2001, the NAPPS Board unanimously voted to establish an award intended to recognize an individual who has demonstrated professionalism and distinguished service to our association and the process serving profession. This award was also unanimously voted to be named after founding member, Donald C. 'Mac' MacDonald who has always embodied the spirit of the award. He taught the principals of professionalism and helping others, not just to his employees, but also to the competition.

The Donald C. 'Mac' MacDonald Award is the highest honor acknowledged in NAPPS. Not necessarily given every year, it is given to those who go above and beyond what is expected in this profession when deserved.
